### No refunds, credits, or transfers

All class cards must be purchased **prior** to registering for any class to use the card towards tuition.

Any discount rate must be requested in-person prior to registering for a class for it to be effective.

Discounts must be renewed each Fall.

- Class cards purchased for the Spring Semester are valid through June 2, 2024. No extensions or refunds will be issued for unused cards.
- College student rates are available for current students. You must present a valid, current college ID.
- Professional rates are available for professional dancers and dance teachers in professional dance organizations. You must present a union card, recent paystub, or company ID.

### Drop-In Classes:

Unless marked as an Enrollment Class Series, all Adult Division classes are drop-in classes, or "pay as you go". Students may begin at any time during the session. Class capacities are limited and online pre-registration is highly recommended. There are no refunds for single classes or credits to 10-Class Cards for a missed class if a student pre-registers online.

### Enrollment Class Series<sup>1</sup>:

These classes are *not* drop-in classes. Enrollment is available until each class is full, and classes are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. No make-up classes are offered. Enrollment-based classes cannot be prorated if student registers after the first week of classes. Register at Joffrey Academy Reception.

#### Pointe Enrollment Series *\*Instructor approval required\**

**Tuesdays, 8:15-9:00pm - 9 weeks (\$135)**

**Session Dates: January 23-March 19 & March 26-May 28**

This nine-week series focuses on beginning pointe work. For the safety of the students, it is mandatory that they take two ballet technique classes per week, including the Intermediate Ballet class immediately preceding Pointe. The instructor will need to approve student's enrollment in Pointe during the Tuesday technique class. Please pick up an approval form from Reception as you check in for Intermediate Ballet. Once approved, the student may join Pointe the following week.

### Master Class Series<sup>2</sup>:

This year the Joffrey Academy of Dance will be offering a Master Class Series taught by various Joffrey Company artists and professionals. This series is available only to select Joffrey Academy students. Eligible students include Pre-Professional Division Levels V and VI, Conservatory, Ballet Trainee, Contemporary Ballet Trainee, Studio Company, and the Adult Open Division. Classes will take place on Friday evenings from 6:45-9:15pm. Class content and location are subject to vary. Students interested in dancing on pointe in this class must currently be working on pointe outside of this class; all other students are welcome to participate in ballet slippers. Master Class Series cost is included in Pre-Professional Division Level VI tuition. All other eligible students will need to register and pay individually for each class the week they would like to attend.

### Late Arrival Policy:

Our classes require a proper warm-up to avoid injury; therefore, either Reception or Faculty may ask students to not participate if they arrive in the studio more than 10 minutes late.

### Attire:

In general, close-fitting clothing that allows the dancer to feel comfortable and allows for proper instruction is recommended. Dance attire is not required. No costumes or tutus, please.

**The Joffrey Academy is no longer accepting cash.** We would like to encourage all adult students to register for their class(es) in advance to ensure a place in the class. Online registration is available up until the start of the class. Walk-in registrations are still welcome with payment by card but a Club Automation account will need to be made in advance.
